## NSC Uniform Regulations Updated February 2023

Rings - not permitted

Necklaces – culturally significant items/necklaces may be worn but not visible

Earrings – a maximum of 3 per ear. Any colour is acceptable however, should only be 1cm sleepers or small studs or keepers

Nose piercing – 1 small stud no more than 1mm in diameter

Tongue piercings – not permitted

Bracelets – one only to be worn

Nail polish – clear nail polish only

Hair – natural hair colours

**Year 7 - 10** students with hair any longer than the bottom of the school shirt collar must have their hair tied back. All long bits (e.g. full length fringe) included so that hair is secured back and kept off the face

**Year 11 - 13** students may leave their hair out as long as it is clean and tidy (brushed). In certain situations, hair must be tied up on request (eg. Food technology, workshop, science).

Facial hair – not permitted

Skin – any tattoos must be covered

NSC hoodies or activity tops (e.g. Young farmers/tournament tops) – hoodies and activity tops are not to be worn with the NSC uniform. NSC hoodies may be worn with the PE uniform. No other hoodies or tops are permitted and must be removed before entering the school grounds

PE shorts or tights – only plain navy or black to be worn

Jackets – only plain navy or black. Must have a full length zip and full length arms, eg. softshells and puffers

Headwear - hats (caps, bucket hats and wide brim hats) & beanies (with or without pom poms) must be plain navy or black. No offensive or inappropriate logos (eg alcohol) are permitted

Shirts – white long or short sleeved to be worn with the kilt. Black/Blue or White can be worn with shorts/skirts/trousers (must be regulation style). Polypros can be worn, however must be of a similar colour to the shirt/polo.

Ties – optional for junior students and **compulsory** for Year 11-13 students

NSC blazer – compulsory for Year 11-13 and must be worn at official occasions, e.g. assembly, prize giving and formal school trips

Socks & Tights - white above ankle or knee length socks are to be worn with navy shorts/skirts and trousers (not low cut or patterned) or Navy NSC school socks with shorts/trousers (refer to uniform combinations). Navy tights, knee highs or NSC navy socks are to be worn with the kilt

Traveling - students who have PE or clubs in period 5 may wear the PE uniform home providing it is the correct uniform. If not, the full school uniform must be changed into
